



GOOGLE MAPS

Eden's Gate Villa is located in the parish of St. Andrew just outside the village of Wesley. It is a mere 15 minutes from the Douglas-Charles Airport.

- Turn left out of the airport and follow the main road, Dr Nicholas Liverpool Hwy, to the village of Wesley.
- Continue through the village. You will pass an area of heavy construction with a number of speed bumps.
- After the last speed bump take the right onto the Eden Estate feeder road marked "Private."
- Your destination will be at the end of the estate road.

The guidebook has a pin location for your convenience.



TRANSPORTATION

Car Rentals

We highly recommend renting a car for your visit. There are a number of car rental agencies on the island offering vehicles for rent. You will need to obtain a driver's permit which cost \$30 (US\$12). You must be between 25 and 65 years old, with two years' driving experience to qualify for a driver's permit. In Dominica we drive on the **LEFT** side of the road.

Taxi

Taxis are readily available at the airport and in town. See our TOURS page for our recommended taxi and tour operators.

Bus

The public transportation system, which mainly consists of minibus operators, is a much less reliable way to get around. Fares range between EC\$2 (less than US\$1) and EC\$11 (or around US\$4), but the private taxis are significantly more reliable.




THINGS TO KNOW: WHEN YOU ARE HERE



Trash and Compost

Put all trash in bins provided. Please put all food scraps in the compost bins located in the freezer.



Air Conditioning

The ocean breeze is often enough to keep you cool, but for an additional chill while sleeping, the AC unit in the bedroom is a wonderful remedy. The remote is mounted on the wall. Please remember to turn it off during the day or when not in use.



Water & Plumbing

Plumbing on the island is gentle. Please only flush toilet paper. The hotwater is a tankless system, so please allow a brief moment for the water to heat up. While the tap water is usually safe to drink please enjoy our complimentary bottled water.



Cleaning Supplies

Cleaning supplies like brooms, mops, and vacuum cleaners are stored in the laundry room off of the kitchen.




Veranda Screens

The remote is located on the wall. Select "0" to control all screens at once. Screens are useful during rain, bright sunshine and bedtime.

Laundry

The washing machine is a Combo Unit; it does both the washing and drying.

● The machine does best with smaller loads.

● Use the supplied detergent sheets.

● There are labels on the machine to translate the important settings.

● The UP/DOWN select buttons will navigate between the WASH/DRY or DRY ONLY settings.

● The bottom row of buttons control:
-Water Temperature
-Wash Time
-Dry Time


-Hit buttons repeatedly to toggle through options.

- 15.Be kind to Brandy.





RECOMMENDATIONS

BEACHES

A 5 minute walk from Eden's Gate is a secluded beach in a protected cove. Look for "Secret Beach" on the Google Map List. To get there, turn right out of the driveway and walk north on the Estate Road to the end. Then follow the path through the wooded area. You'll come out on the red rocks. The beach can be found down to the left. Many locals fish along this coastal area. It can be slippery and rocky, so water shoes are recommended.

RECOMMENDATIONS



Welcome to paradise! To help you settle in and explore the beauty of the northern coast of the island, here's a suggested itinerary for your first day.

Just a 15 minute drive from Eden's Gate is the village of Calibishie, the main village on the scenic north coast of Dominica and a great place to start your island adventures. This ancient fishing village is a slow-paced spot to unwind and relax. Its coast cradles palm-fringed beaches and a dramatic mosaic of steep cliffs, red rocks, and rivers gushing down from the mountains.

Morning: Stock Up on Supplies

Begin your day by visiting A&A Low Price Center, a family-owned store in Calibishie offering a variety of essential products, including groceries, mobile top-ups, and an on-site ATM for your convenience.

Morning: Tour Pointe Baptiste Chocolate Factory

This small chocolate factory is a family business located on the beautiful Pointe Baptiste Estate. The factory supports sustainable practices and gathers cocoa from local farmers. Tour the estate, sample the unique flavors and learn how they make small batch chocolate. Buy some bars and nibs as uniquely Dominican souvenirs.

Afternoon: Relax at Batibou Beach

After gathering your supplies and souvenirs, head to Batibou Beach, often regarded as one of Dominica's most beautiful beaches. This crescent-shaped bay is protected by steep cliffs and mountains covered in rainforest, offering fine sand and palm-lined shores. Park at the top and walk 10 min to the beach, or brave the terrain with your 4x4 to down to the parking area. \$5 per person entry fee. There's a great little restaurant serving lunch most days.

Alternative Lunch Option: Red Rocks Cuisine

Known for authentic Caribbean flavors, this establishment offers fresh ingredients and warm hospitality.

Evening: Dinner at The Sandbar

Conclude your day with dinner at The Sandbar, a local favorite known for its fresh seafood, great pizza and friendly atmosphere. Enjoy a meal while taking in the coastal views.


Alternative Dinner Option: Nets of Reef Restaurant

WATERFALLS, GORGE & HOT SPRINGS DAY

This itinerary brings you to some of our favorite spots on the island, highlighting waterfalls, a gorge featured in *The Pirates of the Caribbean* films, great local dining options and our favorite hot springs spa. *Each of these locations are saved in our shared Google Map List, for easy navigation!*

Travel Tip: Before you leave for the day, reach out to Poz to secure dinner reservations at Poz's Restaurant



Morning - Swim Through Titou Gorge

Drive about 1.5 hours to Titou Gorge, a must-see natural wonder near Laudat. This short adventure lets you swim through a narrow canyon carved by volcanic rock to reach a hidden waterfall—refreshing and magical!



Morning: Visit Trafalgar Falls

Just a 15-minute drive from Titou Gorge, take an easy stroll to the twin waterfalls of Trafalgar Falls. The "Mother" and "Father" falls are stunning, and you can scramble over rocks for closer views or soak near the base.



Lunch: River Rock Cafe and Bar

After exploring the falls, head to River Rock Café and Bar, only a few minutes away. Enjoy delicious Creole-style dishes like fish, chicken, or vegetarian options while surrounded by lush mountains with a river view.

Travel Tip: Ask your server at River Rock Cafe and Bar for directions to Wotten Waven. The main road is often closed to traffic and Google Maps sometimes misses the alternate route.



Afternoon: Soak at Ti Kwen Glo Cho Hot Springs

Drive up to Wotten Waven and unwind at Ti Kwen Glo Cho, a charming rustic hot spring retreat. Relax in the warm mineral pools and enjoy the natural jungle surroundings!

Travel Tip: If you love hot springs and want to explore more, we recommend nearby Da-S'Cape and Screws spas too!



Afternoon: S-Mart Grocery Stop

On your way back to Eden's Gate, stop at this large well stocked grocery store in Roseau to pick up groceries, snacks, and local treats to enjoy later.



Return to Eden's Gate

Make the scenic 1.5-hour drive back to Eden's Gate in Wesley to freshen up, shower, and recharge for dinner.




Evening: Dinner at Poz's in Calibishie

Finish the day with dinner at Poz's, a local gem just 20 minutes away. Known for its fresh seafood and cozy vibe, Poz's offers the perfect laid-back setting to end your day with a satisfying meal.



Alternative Dinner Option: Pagua Bay Bar and Grill

This restaurant boasts carefully curated menus incorporating locally sourced ingredients into exquisite dishes that reflect the locals and the world around them.



RECOMMENDATIONS



The Portsmouth area of the island has everything you could want for an easy day trip! Known for its calm Caribbean seas, great restaurant selection and vibrant energy, this is the second largest city on the island and an easy drive from Eden's Gate.



Morning: Drive to Portsmouth

About 50 minutes by car, this route will take you beyond Calibishie and through several small villages, agricultural land and untouched regions.



Morning: Indian River Tour

Begin your day with a peaceful boat ride along the Indian River, a lush mangrove river that was featured in Pirates of the Caribbean. Guided tours by locals will highlight Dominica's rich flora and fauna, with stops to learn about local history and culture. D Visit the iconic Bush Bar on the river for a refreshing rum punch or fresh juice! Most tours take 1.5-2 hours.



Morning: Snorkeling at Toucari Bay

Toucari Bay is just a short 15-minute drive from the Indian River. The bay offers calm waters, perfect for beginners or experienced snorkelers alike. Known for its black sand, vibrant coral reefs, marine life, and underwater wrecks, there's a lot to see! If snorkeling isn't your thing, you can rent a kayak or just relax on the beach.

Travel Tip: If you plan to eat lunch at Keepin' It Real, we suggest you stop there first and let them know your order and when you want to eat. Then snorkel knowing your meal will be ready when you're done.



Lunch: Keepin' It Real

After snorkeling, enjoy a laid-back lunch at Keepin' It Real, a popular beachfront restaurant in Toucari. Feast on fresh seafood dishes like grilled lobster, fish, or conch, paired with local sides and cold drinks. The vibe is super chill, with tables right on the beach. Service can be slow if you don't order ahead!



Alternative Lunch Option: The Almond Deck

Another Toucari favorite, this casual beach spot open for lunch and dinner most days serves up some really delicious tacos!



Afternoon: Relaxation at Purple Turtle Beach

Head back to Portsmouth (10 minutes) to spend the afternoon soaking in the shallow, warm waters of Purple Turtle Beach, a local and tourist favorite! This beach is a lively spot with more opportunities for water sports. If you're hungry for a snack, The Purple Turtle Beach Club is great.



Alternative Beach: Coconut Beach

Looking for something a little quieter? Spend the afternoon soaking in the shallow, warm waters of Coconut Beach, which features soft sand and a quiet vibe.




Evening: Dinner at Belles Hall Beach Spot
